# **Bill Sapsis Rigging Training**

## **Information Sheet**

## Goals:

Provide training in current entertainment rigging industry practices and equipment and the proper use, inspection and maintenance of that equipment.

## Length:

Daylong sessions are 7-8 hours including lunch and coffee breaks. 1,2 & 3 day sessions are available.

### **Curriculum:**

Fall Arrest, Fall Protection/ and Rescue are required topics. All other topics are developed through discussion with the client to determine their needs and expectations.

#### Format:

Informal. Q & A is encouraged throughout the day.

## **Setting:**

Tables and chairs for attendees.
Small table and a tall stool for presenter.

## **Equipment:**

Video projector with HDMI or VGA. A small PA for larger rooms. Projection screen, cyc or scrim, or similar surface. Blackboard, whiteboard or similar for impromptu drawings.

### **Refreshments:**

Hot tea in the am. Bottled water throughout the day. Lunch can be offsite or in-house. Lunch break to be 1 hour.

## **Attendees:**

Maximum number of attendees should be 35-40

### **Recording:**

Audio and/or video recording is not permitted except by pre-arranged agreement.

A copy of all recordings is to be provided to the presenter.

### Fees:

1-day session \$1,200.00\* 2-day session \$2,300.00\* 3-day session \$3,400.00\*

\*plus expenses. Expenses are defined as roundtrip airfare, lodging, meals, and ground transportation as required.

Six ETCP re-certification credits are available for each day of training.
